- Increase the ability to evaluate actual water use and conservation.

Project Scope

The General Appropriations Act, page VI-61, paragraph 24, calls for the development of:

"....an online tool to consolidate reporting requirements related to the Water Use Survey, annual Water Loss Report, and annual Water Conservation Report. The agency shall also develop an online tool to quantify water conservation savings. The agency shall provide the ability for these reports to be completed, submitted and viewable by the public online".


