I looked at the workgroup #1 task which according to some notes that Ken gave me include tasks 3 & 5 from HB4. I was trying to figure out exactly what the purpose of the survey is and I think that we were discussing that on the conference call as well. Looking at tasks 3 & 5 and from what I heard on the call, it seems to me that the survey is primarily addressing task 5 (develop and implement a public recognition program for water conservation). Is that correct? I have attached the survey and letter with some comments in track changes.

Our other task is to monitor the effectiveness of the statewide water conservation public awareness program. I assume this is the Water IQ program and currently there is no state funding for this program correct? So are we monitoring the implementation via NTMWD, LCRA and others that are using and further developing the Water IQ program and materials? There will be a request to the Legislature to fund Water IQ next session I presume.

I am just trying to get this all clarified so that I am real clear on what we are doing.
